Notice for New York Residents – A consumer credit report may be requested in connection with this application or in connection with updates, renewals or extensions of any credit granted as a result of this application. If you subsequently ask for this information, you will be informed whether or not such report was requested and, if so, the name and address of the agency that furnished the report.

Notice for Ohio Residents - Ohio laws against discrimination require that all creditors make credit equally available to all credit worthy customers, and that credit reporting agencies maintain separate histories on each individual upon request. The Ohio Civil Rights Commission administers compliance with this law.

Notice for Married Wisconsin Residents – Wisconsin law provides that no agreement, unilateral statement or court decree relating to marital property shall adversely affect a creditor's interest, unless prior to the time credit is granted the creditor is furnished a copy of the agreement or decree, or has actual knowledge of the adverse provision. You must indicate the name of your spouse on the Installment Contract, and the address if different from yours.

Notice for California and Utah Residents – As required by law you are hereby notified that a negative credit report reflecting on your credit record may be submitted to a credit-reporting agency if you fail to fulfill the terms of your credit obligations.

Notice for Maine Residents – If the creditor approves this application, you will be required to obtain and maintain physical damage insurance on the collateral securing the debt. You have a right of free choice in the selection of the agent and insurer through or by which the insurance is placed.
